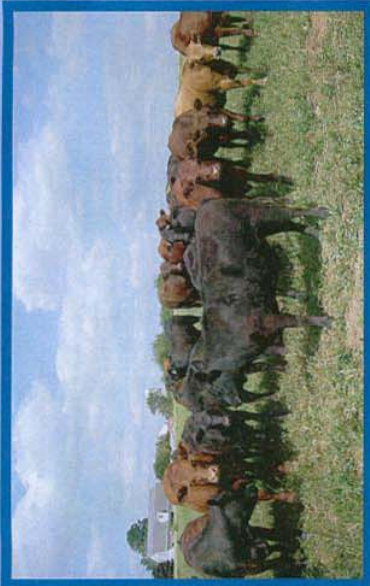


Grass Fed Beef



Paradise Pastures grass fed beef are fed only grass and hay, producing high quality nutrient dense meat. At harvest our beef is then dry aged for two to three weeks for the best flavor and tenderness.

Grass quality is at its best during the spring and fall seasons. Therefore, we harvest most of our beef at the end of those seasons. Beef is available year round with quantity discounts at harvest time in late fall and late spring.

Pastured Pork



At Paradise Pastures, our hogs are raised on pastures. They are supplemented with skimmed milk, corn and minerals. Pork is available year round with quantity discounts in fall and early winter.

About Our Family Farm



Our 102 acre farm has been in the Fisher family since 1944 when our grandfather Aaron bought the farm. The farm, now in the third generation of Fishers is currently operated by Melvin and Annie Fisher and their four sons. Melvin Sr., 57, owns and manages the dairy herd. Annie, 49, has a full time job cooking and house keeping for her husband and four boys. She still helps out if things get really busy with farm work or packing. John Lee, 25, owns and manages the direct marketing, packaging, beef, poultry, and pork parts of the business. Alvin, 19, does much of the pasture and field work and assists with packaging. Aaron, 15, feeds the cows, assists with field work, and helps wherever else needed. Melvin Jr., 11, cares for the calves and helps out wherever possible when he is not in school. We have two daughters Mary Ella, 24, and Fanny Ruth, 21, both are married and live off the farm.
